

Armed Forces Personnel (Total)

Armed forces personnel are active duty military personnel, including paramilitary forces if their training, organisation, equipment, and control suggest they may be used to support or replace regular military forces.

China and India are the global superpowers in terms of armed personnel, with 2.95 mil and 2.63 mil soldiers at the end of 2010; however, one has to add that a quarter of Chinese and more than a half of Indian armed personnel are reserve personnel. With more than 1.75 mil reserve personnel, the Indian Army is therefore the world's largest standing volunteer army.




