


Foreign-born Population (As % Of Total Population)

Foreign-born means a person whose place of birth, or residence of the mother at the time of birth, is outside the country of his/her usual residence.

In 2011, there were 48.9 million foreign-born people living in the EU27, with 16.5 million born in another member state than the one in which they live (3.3% of the EU population) and 32.4 million born in a country outside the EU27 (6.4% of the EU population).

In total, foreign-born people accounted for 9.7% of the total population of the EU27. The number of foreign-born people exceeded the number of foreign citizens in almost all EU member states.

HELGI'S POINT OF VIEW


The percentage of foreign born in a country is the product mostly of immigration rates, but is also affected by emigration rates and birth and death rates in the destination country. For example the United Kingdom and Ireland are destination countries for migrants from Eastern Europe, Africa, and Asia, but are themselves source countries for immigration to other Anglosphere countries.

The countries with the highest rates of immigration are wealthy countries with relatively open nationality or migration laws including Canada, Australia, and the Persian Gulf States.

The largest foreign-born population in the world is in the United States, which was home to 33 million foreign-residents in 2002, or 11.8% of the population.

Following the WWII and 40 years of Communism, the Czech Republic remains largely a homogenous society. Despite increasing, the share of foreigners remains well below 10%.



Osoby narozené v zahraničí (jako % celkové populace)

Osoba narozená v zahraničí je člověk, jehož místo narození nebo místo trvalého pobytu jeho matky je v době jeho narození mimo zemi jeho/jejího obvyklého pobytu.

V roce 2011 se v zemích EU27 narodilo 48.9 mil. cizinců, přičemž 16.5 mil. z nich se narodilo v jiném členském státě než v tom, ve kterém žijí (3.3% populace EU) a 32.4 mil. se narodilo v zemi mimo EU27 (6.4% populace EU).

Počet nově narozených cizinců čílal 9.7% z celkové populace EU27. Počet narozených cizinců přesáhl počet cizinců žijících v dané zemi téměř ve všech členských státech EU.


Podíl cizinců ve společnosti je převážně výsledkem míry imigrace, ovšem může být také výrazně ovlivněn emigračními trendy a mírou porodnosti a úmrtnosti v zemi destinace. Velká Británie a Irsko jsou příklady zemí, do kterých proudí imigranti ze východní Evropy, Afriky a Asie, ovšem slouží také jako významný zdroj imigrace do jiných anglofonních zemí.

Země s nejvyšší mírou imigrace jsou bohaté státy s relativně vstřícnými imigračními zákony jako jsou například Kanada, Austrálie a státy Perského zálivu.

Spojené státy americké jsou zemí s největším počtem osob narozených v zahraničí. V roce 2002 tam žilo 33 miliónu zahraničních residentů, což tvořilo zhruba 11.8% celkové populace.

Česká republika je po emigraci části populace po druhé světové válce a 40 letech komunismu relativně homogenní společností. Podíl cizinců se zvyšuje, ale zůstává výrazně pod 10%.
