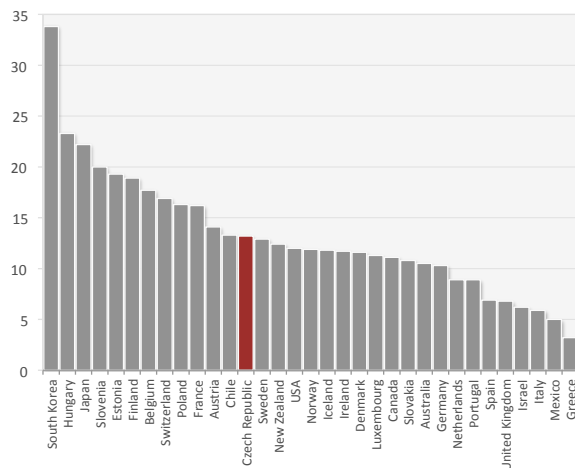

Suicide Deaths Per 100,000 People

Approximately one million people die from suicide according to the WHO, which represents a global mortality rate of 16 people per 100,000 or one death every 40 seconds.

HELGI'S POINT OF VIEW

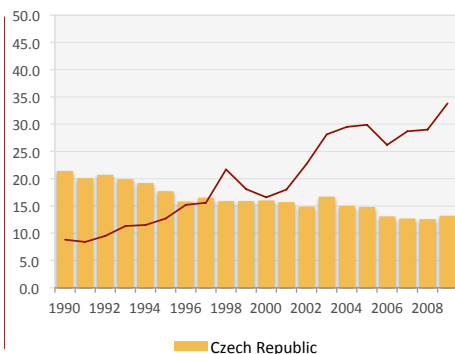
In the last 45 years suicide rates have increased by 60% worldwide. Although suicide rates have traditionally been highest amongst elderly males, rates among young people have been increasing to such an extent that they are now the group at highest risk in a third of all countries.

Mental health disorders (particularly depression and substance abuse) are associated with more than 90% of all cases of suicide.

The WHO also states that Eastern Europe show the highest suicide rates, but nearly 30% of all suicides worldwide occur in India and China.

While number of suicides has been declining in most Central European countries in the last decade (with the exception of Poland, where suicide rate stays at around 15 per 100,000 since 1999), the numbers from South Korea, where the rate tripled just over the last two decades are scaring!

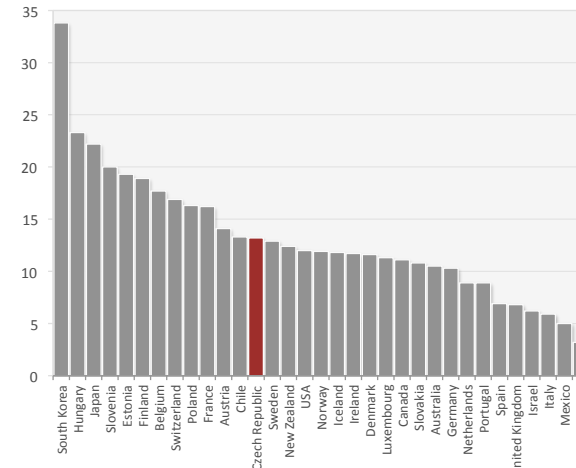

Počet sebevražd na 100,000 obyvatel

Podle Světové Zdravotnické Organizace (WHO) umírá ročně na celém světě přibližně jeden milion lidí v důsledku sebevraždy, což představuje zhruba 16 osob na 100,000 obyvatel, neboli jedno úmrtí každých 40 sekund.

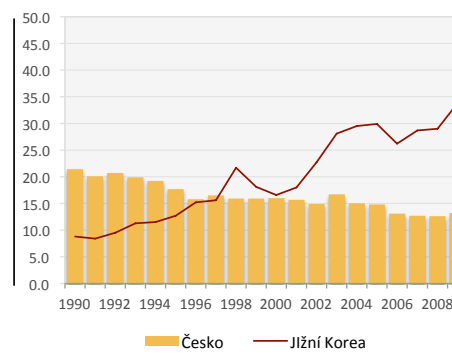
HELGIHO POINTA

V posledních 45 letech se počet sebevražd celosvětově zvýšil o 60%. Ačkoli sebevraždy byly tradičně nejrozšířenější u starších mužů, v současnosti rostou sebevraždy u mladých lidí tolik, že mladí lidé jsou nyní skupina s nejvyšším rizikem sebevraždy ve třetině všech zemí.

Poruchy duševního zdraví (zejména deprese a zneužívání návykových látek) jsou spojeny s více než 90% všech případů sebevraždy. WHO rovněž uvádí, že východní Evropa vykazuje nejvyšší počty sebevražd, ale téměř 30% všech sebevražd na celém světě se vyskytují v Indii a Číně.

Zatímco počet sebevražd ve východní Evropě klesá již po dvě desetiletí, (s výjimkou Polska, kde počet sebevražd stagnuje na 15 na 100,000 obyvatel), čísla z Jižní Koreje opravdu odstrašující. Od roku 1990 se tam počet sebevražd více než ztrojnásobil!
